News of the Prophet<sup>saww</sup> to (Syeda) Fatima<sup>asws</sup> and her<sup>asws</sup> cheerfulness after her<sup>asws</sup> grief, etc..

He said, 'It was narrated to us by Abu Al Abbas Muhammad Bin Yaqoub, from Muhammad Bin Is'haq Al Saqany, from Usman Bin Umar, from Israil, from Maysara Bin Habeeb, from Al Minhal Bin Umar (Amro), from Ayesah Bint Talha, from Ayesha who said,

'I did not see anyone who resembled more with Rasool-Allah<sup>saww</sup> in speech, and narration than (Syeda) Fatima<sup>asws</sup>, and it was so that whenever she<sup>asws</sup> came over to him<sup>saww</sup>, he<sup>saww</sup> was welcoming her<sup>asws</sup> and would be standing up for her<sup>asws</sup>, and would grab her<sup>asws</sup> hand and kiss her<sup>asws</sup> hand, and sit her<sup>asws</sup> in his<sup>saww</sup> seat. And it was so that whenever Rasool-Allah<sup>saww</sup> went over to her<sup>asws</sup>, she<sup>asws</sup> would be welcoming him<sup>saww</sup>, and would grab his<sup>saww</sup> hand, and Syeda<sup>asws</sup> would kiss it.

She<sup>asws</sup> came over to him<sup>saww</sup> during the illness in which he<sup>saww</sup> passed away. So he<sup>saww</sup> was welcoming her<sup>asws</sup>, and kissed her<sup>asws</sup> and told her<sup>asws</sup> a secret. So she<sup>asws</sup> cried. Then he<sup>saww</sup> told her (another) secret, and she<sup>asws</sup> smiled.

Then he<sup>saww</sup> revealed a secret to me<sup>asws</sup> and informed me<sup>asws</sup> that I<sup>asws</sup> would be the first one of his<sup>saww</sup> family to meet him<sup>saww</sup>. So I<sup>asws</sup> smiled".<sup>1</sup>

By Allahazwil Had you placed foremost the one whom Allahazwi Placed as foremost and placed last the one whom Allahazwi Placed last, and made the inheritance to be where Allahazwi had Made it to be, neither would a category from the Obligatory ones of Allahazwi been reduced to poverty, nor would the Guardian of Allah azwi have been reduced to poverty, nor would two (people) have differed in the Judgment of Allahazwj. Therefore taste the evil consequences of what you wasted with regards to it, due to what your hands have sent forward [26:227] and they who act unjustly shall come to know the turning they shall be Overturned with".2

'I heard Abu Abdullah Ja'far<sup>asws</sup> Bin Muhammad<sup>asws</sup> saying: 'Ali<sup>asws</sup> was not found to be judging with a judgment except an origin in the Sunnah was found for it. And it was so that Ali<sup>asws</sup> was saying: 'If two men were to dispute to me<sup>asws</sup>, and I<sup>asws</sup> judge between the two, then many years pass by, then they come to me regarding that very matter, I<sup>asws</sup> would judge between them with one (and the same) judgment, because the judgment neither recedes nor changes".3

It was narrated to me by the chief ascetic Waildy, and the judge Abu Ahmad Bin Ibrahim Bin Mutarrif Bin Al Hassan Al Mutarrify that the Sheykh Saeed Bin Abdul Rahman Bin Muhammad Bin Abdllah Bin Idrees Al Astarabady wrote to them saying, 'It was narrated to me by Abu Ahmad Muhammad Bin Ibrahim Bin Atrawiya Al Astarabady repeatedly from his words, from Abdul Raheem Al Baghdady, from the trustworthy, from Tawoos Bi Kaysan Al Yamany who said,

'I went out to the Sacred House of Allah<sup>azwj</sup>, and with us was Al-Hajjaj Bin Al-Yusuf Al-Saqafy (the Umayyid Caliph). So while we were going, we were with a Bedouin, nomadic by nature, and he was exclaiming *Talbiyya* and saying in his *Talbiyya*, 'Here I am O Allah<sup>azwj</sup>, here I am! I have exclaimed for You<sup>azwj</sup>, here I am! There are no associates for You<sup>azwj</sup>. Here I am. The Praise and the Bounties are for You<sup>azwj</sup>, and the Kingdom. There are no associates for You<sup>azwj</sup> for Your<sup>azwj</sup> Speech. O Allah<sup>azwj</sup>! For You<sup>azwj</sup>, from the creatures, is no similar to that. Then into the Fire is (that one who has left) Your<sup>azwj</sup> Rope (Means to Approach You<sup>azwj</sup>), and the night (Evil) what it dissolves, and the flowing in the skies are upon a flowing from Your<sup>azwj</sup> Rope (Means to Approach You<sup>azwj</sup>). Your<sup>azwj</sup> Rasools<sup>as</sup> pursued us and made us travel (on a way) and argued against us from You<sup>azwj</sup> and for You<sup>azwj</sup>!'

So Al-Hajjaj heard that, and he said, 'A *Talbiyya* of an atheist, by the Lord<sup>azwj</sup> of the Kabah. Come me with the Bedouin!' So they came with him, and he said, 'O Bedouin! From where (are you) and to where (are you going)?' He said, 'From the deep glens to the Ancient House (Kabah)'. He said, 'And where do the deep glens happen to be?' He said, 'At Al-Iraq'. He said, 'And which place from Al-Iraq?' He said, 'From the middle'. He said, 'So, it there an Emir for you in the middle (of Al-Iraq)?' He said, 'A despicable human called Al-Hajjaj'.

He said, 'Is he staying (there) or departed?' He said, 'But, departed for Hajj'. So he said, 'Has he utilised an office bearer upon you?' He said, 'Yes, a human more despicable than him, called Muhammad Bin Yusuf'. He said, 'And how did you leave him behind?' He said, 'I left him behind as obese and gross'. He said, 'It isn't about this that I am asking you'. So about what are you asking me, O you?' He said, 'About his ways among the people'. He said, 'I left him behind as an unjust one, a tyrant, seizing without a right and giving among ones without the right'.

He said, 'Woe be unto you! I am Al-Hajjaj, and that is my brother Muhammad Bin Yusuf. But, do you not recognise my honour?' So the Bedouin said, 'Or do you not recognise my honour? I am with the Lord<sup>azwj</sup> of the worlds'. Al-Hajjaj said, 'O Bedouin! It suffices you being an atheist'. He said, 'I am not an atheist, but am a Monotheist'. He said, 'But, to whom are you a monotheist?' He said, 'To Allah<sup>azwj</sup> Who Created the skies and the earth'. He said, 'So you recognise Allah<sup>azwj</sup>?' He said, 'Yes, upon the goodness'. (He was silent)'.

He (the Bedouin) said, 'And what I recognise Allah<sup>azwj</sup>, He<sup>azwj</sup> isn't with a lineage, and He<sup>azwj</sup> Sees and is not with a body. He<sup>azwj</sup> is integral but is not with an end-point. He<sup>azwj</sup> Forbids and does not renew, and He<sup>azwj</sup> Visualises and is not veiled, and He<sup>azwj</sup> uncovers and there are no eons without Him<sup>azwj</sup> opposite to its eras. But, the Majesty of that is Great, Exalted, Who Created, So He<sup>azwj</sup> Mastered, and Imaged, so was excellent, and High. So He<sup>azwj</sup> Enabled and Mastered upon the affairs by His<sup>azwj</sup> Mighty. He<sup>azwj</sup> cannot be describe by the movement, because it (movement) is declining, and nor by the stillness because it is an attribute of the resembled with the examples. The units are not concealed upon Him<sup>azwj</sup> with the states. He<sup>azwj</sup> is the Knower of the unseen and the seen, the Great, the Exalted'.

So Al-Hajjaj said, 'O Bedouin! You have been excellent regarding the Oneness Tawheed). So what is your word regarding this man, the Sent one, Muhammad<sup>saww</sup>?' He said, 'A Prophet<sup>saww</sup> of Mercy. Allah<sup>azwj</sup> Sent him<sup>saww</sup> when there was a gap from the Rasools<sup>as</sup>, and (a period of) straying from the communities. And the communities, in those days we in the ignorance. The ignorant ones were not making a Religion for Allah<sup>azwj</sup> with a Religion nor were they reciting a Book of His<sup>azwj</sup>. They were the companions of the stones and mud (idol worshippers), and (financial) constraints and poverty, worshipping idols besides Allah<sup>azwj</sup> and taking to the images until Allah<sup>azwj</sup> Mighty and Majestic Sent a Prophet<sup>azwj</sup> with a Message who<sup>saww</sup> gathered their affairs'.

So the Bedouin was silent, and he said within himself, 'If I ratify him, he would kill me, and if I lie to him, so with what (face) would I meet Muhammad<sup>saww</sup>?' Then he said, 'The world is transitory and the Hereafter is everlasting. Take it to you from the peacefulness. Ali<sup>asws</sup> Bin Abu Talib<sup>asws</sup> is the caller to Allah<sup>azwj</sup> and the son-in-law of the *Mursif*<sup>saww</sup>. Indeed he<sup>asws</sup> is. And he<sup>asws</sup> is the ship of salvation, and an ocean between the bode and rain between the rest, fighter against the Polytheists and repressor of the aggressors, and Emir of the Momineen, and a cousin of the Prophet<sup>saww</sup> of Allah<sup>azwj</sup>, may Allah<sup>azwj</sup> Send *Salawat* upon him<sup>saww</sup> and his<sup>saww</sup> Progeny<sup>asws</sup> altogether.

The Chaste one (Al-Batoul) was Blessed with them<sup>asws</sup> and the Rasool<sup>saww</sup> named them<sup>asws</sup>, and the Majestic Teknonymed them<sup>asws</sup>, and Jibraeel<sup>as</sup> played with them<sup>asws</sup> (when babies), and Mikaeel<sup>as</sup> trained them<sup>asws</sup>. So, is there an equal for them<sup>asws</sup>?'

He said, 'You are more knowing of yourself'. He said, 'Say something regarding your Emir'. He said, 'Then I shall disappoint you and will not cheer you'. He said, 'Transmit what you know'. He said, 'I do not know you except for an unjust one, a tyrant. You are killing the friends of Allah<sup>azwj</sup> without a right'.

The safety is in the silence, and rather the faults begin with the frequent talking. And when you fear blame in a gathering, so baptize your tongue in the soft palate and remain silent, and preserve your tongue. Do not be saying, for you would be afflicted. The affliction is allocated with the speaking'.

I ask You<sup>azwj</sup>, O my God<sup>azwj</sup>, and the God<sup>azwj</sup> of my forefathers *[2:140] Ibrahim and Ismail and Yaqoub and the tribes*, and by the right of *[19:1] Kaf Ha Ya Ayn Suad*, and *[20:1] Ta Ha*, and *[36:1] Ya Seen [36:2] I swear by the Wise Quran*, that You<sup>azwj</sup> Send *Salawat* upon Muhammad<sup>saww</sup> and the Progeny<sup>asws</sup> of Muhammad<sup>saww</sup>, and that You<sup>azwj</sup> Free the hand of the executioner'.

So she<sup>asws</sup> was silent and did not turn away her<sup>asws</sup> face, and Rasool-Allah<sup>saww</sup> did not see an abhorrence in it. So he<sup>saww</sup> came out and he<sup>saww</sup> was saying: 'Allah<sup>azwj</sup> is the

Greatest! Her<sup>asws</sup> silence is her<sup>asws</sup> acceptance'. And Jibraeel<sup>saww</sup> came unto him<sup>saww</sup> and he<sup>as</sup> said: 'Marry her<sup>asws</sup> to Ali<sup>asws</sup> Bin Abu Talib<sup>asws</sup>, for Allah<sup>azwj</sup> is Pleased with her<sup>asws</sup> being for him<sup>asws</sup> and is Pleased with him<sup>asws</sup> being for her<sup>asws</sup>'.

Ali<sup>asws</sup> said: 'So Rasool-Allah<sup>saww</sup> got me<sup>asws</sup> married, then came to me<sup>asws</sup> and grabbed my<sup>asws</sup> hand and he<sup>saww</sup> said: 'Arise, in the Name of Allah<sup>azwj</sup> and say: 'Upon the Blessings of Allah<sup>azwj</sup>! Whatever Allah<sup>azwj</sup> so Desires! There is no Strength except with Allah<sup>azwj</sup>! I<sup>asws</sup> rely upon Allah<sup>azwj</sup>!"

Then he<sup>saww</sup> went with me<sup>asws</sup> he<sup>asws</sup> seated me<sup>asws</sup> in her<sup>asws</sup> presence, then said: 'O Allah<sup>azwj</sup>! Both of them<sup>asws</sup> are the most Beloved of Your<sup>azwj</sup> creatures to You<sup>azwj</sup>, therefore Love them<sup>asws</sup>, and Bless in their<sup>asws</sup> offspring, and Makes a Protector from You<sup>azwj</sup> to be upon them<sup>asws</sup>, and I<sup>saww</sup> seek Refuge for both of them<sup>asws</sup> with You<sup>azwj</sup> and (for) their<sup>asws</sup> offspring, from the Pelted Satan<sup>la</sup>".<sup>19</sup>

From Abu Hureyra who said, 'The one who Fasts on the eighteenth of Zilhajj, Allah azwj would Write for him the Fasts of sixty months, and that is the Day of Ghadeer Khumm, due to Rasool-Allah grabbing the hand of Aliasws Bin Abu Talibasws, and saying: 'The one whose Master Isaww was, so Aliasws is his Master'. So Umar said, 'Congratulations! Congratulations! You have become my Master and the Master of every *Momin* and *Momina*". 20

From Ibn Abbas who said, 'Rasool-Allah<sup>saww</sup> said: 'The one who intends that he lives my<sup>saww</sup> life, and he dies my<sup>saww</sup> passing away, and that he settles into the eternal Paradise which my<sup>saww</sup> Lord<sup>azwj</sup> Promised me<sup>saww</sup>, so let him befriend Ali<sup>asws</sup> Bin Abu Talib<sup>asws</sup>, and let him befriend his<sup>asws</sup> offspring from after him<sup>asws</sup>, for they<sup>asws</sup> have been Created from my<sup>saww</sup> essence (clay), and have been Graced my<sup>saww</sup> understanding and my<sup>saww</sup> knowledge. So woe be unto the beliers from my<sup>saww</sup> community of their<sup>asws</sup>

merits, the cutters of my<sup>saww</sup> relationship regarding them<sup>asws</sup>. May Allah<sup>azwj</sup> not Let them attain my<sup>saww</sup> intercession".<sup>21</sup>

#### Sermon of Al-Hassan<sup>asws</sup> on the Day of the Camel in Al-Basra

قَالَ: حَدَّثَنَا مُحَمَّدُ بْنُ سِيرِينَ قَالَ سَمِعْتُ غَيْرَ وَاحِدٍ مِنْ مَشِيخَةٍ أَهْلِ الْبَصْرَةِ:

He said, 'It was narrated to us by Muhammad Bin Sireen who said, 'I heard someone else from the Sheykhs of the people of Al Basra (saying),

لَمَّا فَرَغَ عَلِيُّ بْنُ أَبِي طَالِبٍ ع مِنَ الْجَمَلِ عَرَضَ لَهُ مَرَضٌ وَ حَضَرَتِ الْجُمُعَةُ فَتَأَخَّرَ عَنْهَا قَالَ لِابْنِهِ الْحَسَنِ ع انْطَلِقْ يَا بُنَيَّ فَجَمِّعْ بِالنَّاسِ

'When Ali<sup>asws</sup> Bin AbuTalib<sup>asws</sup> was free from the (battle of the) camel, an illness presented itself to him<sup>asws</sup>, and Friday came up, and he<sup>asws</sup> was delayed from it. He<sup>asws</sup> said to his<sup>asws</sup> son<sup>asws</sup> Al-Hassan<sup>asws</sup>: 'Go, O my<sup>asws</sup> son<sup>asws</sup>, and (pray the *Salat* of) Friday with them (leading them)'.

فَأَقْبَلَ الْحَسَنُ إِلَى الْمَسْجِدِ فَلَمَّا اسْتَقَلَّ عَلَى الْمِنْبَرِ حَمِدَ اللَّهَ وَ أَثْنَى عَلَيْهِ وَ تَشَهَّدَ وَ صَلَّى عَلَى رَسُولِ اللَّهِ ص ثُمَّ قَالَ أَيُّهَا النَّاسُ إِنَّ اللَّهَ اخْتَارَنَا بِالنَّبُوَّةِ وَ اصْطَفَانَا عَلَى خَلْقِهِ وَ أَنْزَلَ عَلَيْنَا كِتَابَهُ وَ وَحْيَهُ

So Al-Hassan<sup>asws</sup> came to the Masjid, and when he<sup>asws</sup> got on the Pulpit, he<sup>asws</sup> Praised Allah<sup>azwj</sup> and Lauded upon Him<sup>azwj</sup>, and testified, and sent *Salawat* upon Rasool-Allah<sup>saww</sup>, then said: 'O you people! Allah<sup>azwj</sup> Chose us<sup>asws</sup> with the Prophet-hood, and Chose us<sup>asws</sup> upon His<sup>azwj</sup> creatures, and Sent down the Book upon us<sup>asws</sup> and His<sup>azwj</sup> Revelation.

وَ ايْمُ اللَّهِ لَا يَنْقُصُنَا أَحَدٌ مِنْ حَقَّنَا شَيْئًا إِلَّا يَنْقُصُهُ فِي عَاجِلِ دُنْيَاهُ وَ آجِلِ آخِرَتِهِ وَ لَا تَكُونُ عَلَيْنَا دَوْلَةٌ إِلَّا كَانَتُ لَنَا الْعَاقِبَةُ وَ لَتَعْلَمُنَّ نَبَأَهُ بَعْدَ حِينِ

And I<sup>asws</sup> swear by Allah<sup>azwj</sup>! No one would reduce anything from our<sup>asws</sup> rights except there would be a reduction in the present of his world and the future of his Hereafter, and the government would not happen to be for us<sup>asws</sup> except there would be an endresult for us<sup>asws</sup>, and I<sup>asws</sup> shall be giving the news of it after a while'.

ثُمَّ جَمَّعَ بِالنَّاسِ وَ بَلَغَ أَبَاهُ عَ كَلَامُهُ فَلَمَّا انْصَرَفَ إِلَى أَبِيهِ نَظَرَ إِلَيْهِ فَمَا مَلِكَ عَبْرَتَهُ أَنْ سَالَتْ عَلَى خَدَّيْهِ ثُمَّ اسْتَدْنَاهُ إِلَيْهِ فَقَبَّلَ بَيْنِ عَيْنَيْهِ وَ قَالَ بِأَبِي أَنْتَ وَ أُمِّي ذُرِّيَّةً بَعْضُها مِنْ بَعْضٍ وَ اللَّهُ سَمِيعٌ عَلِيمٌ.

Then he<sup>asws</sup> led Friday *Salat* with the people, and his<sup>asws</sup> speech reached his<sup>asws</sup> father. So when he<sup>asws</sup> left to go to his<sup>asws</sup> father, he<sup>asws</sup> looked at him<sup>asws</sup>, and he<sup>asws</sup> had not control of his<sup>asws</sup> tears from flowing upon his<sup>asws</sup> cheeks. Then he<sup>asws</sup> drew him<sup>asws</sup>

nearer and kissed between his asws eyes and said: 'By my asws father as and my as mother s! [3:34] Offspring one from the other; and Allah is Hearing, Knowing". 22

From Qays Bin Sa'ad Ubada who said, 'I heard Aliasws Bin Abu Talibasws saying: 'I asws would be the first one to be keeling in front of Allahazwi Mighty and Majestic on the Day of Judgment, regarding the disputing (of people against us as ws)". 23

From Hakeem Bin Hassan, from Uqba Al Hajry, from his uncle who said,

'I heard Ali<sup>asws</sup> upon the Pulpit and he<sup>asws</sup> was saying: 'I<sup>asws</sup> shall be saying such words today, no one before has said it before me<sup>asws</sup> nor would be saying it after me<sup>asws</sup> except for a liar! I<sup>asws</sup> am a servant of Allah<sup>azwj</sup>, and brother<sup>asws</sup> of Rasool-Allah<sup>saww</sup>, and I<sup>asws</sup> married the Chieftess of the women of the community".<sup>24</sup>

He said, 'It was narrated to us by Umar Bin Sabit, from Jabala Bin Suheym, from his father who said,

'When allegiance had been pledged to Amir Al-Momineen Aliasws Bin Abu Talibasws, it reached him<sup>asws</sup> that Muawiya had withheld from manifesting the allegiance to him<sup>asws</sup> and said, 'Acknowledge to me upon Syria and my office bearers whom Usman had appointed, I will pledge allegiance to him asws'.

So Al-Mugheira came over to Ali<sup>asws</sup> Amir Al-Momineen<sup>asws</sup> and said to him, 'O Amir Al-Momineen<sup>asws</sup>! Muawiya is one you<sup>asws</sup> have known, and he was made the ruler of Syria by the one who was before you<sup>asws</sup>, so you<sup>asws</sup> should (also) keep him as ruler for the affairs to be consistent, then isolate him if there is a change for you<sup>asws</sup>. So Amir Al-Momineen saws said: 'Can you guarantee to me saws of my saws life-span, O Mugheira, during my<sup>asws</sup> keeping him as ruler up to him vacating it?' He said, 'No'.

He<sup>asws</sup> said: 'So will Allah<sup>azwj</sup> Mighty and Majestic not ask me<sup>asws</sup> making him a ruler over two men from the Muslims for one dark night, ever? *[18:51] nor did I Take those who lead (others) astray as Aiders*. But send someone to him and call him to what is in my<sup>asws</sup> hand from the Truth, so he if answers, so he is a man from the Muslim. For him would be what is for them, and upon him would be what is upon them. And if he refuses, I<sup>asws</sup> leave his Judgment to Allah<sup>azwj</sup>.

So Al-Mugheira turned around and he was saying: - I advised Ali<sup>asws</sup> regarding the son of Harb (Muawiya) with an advice, but he<sup>asws</sup> rejected, so there is nothing from me for him for a second time. And he<sup>asws</sup> did not accept the advice which I had come with, and it was so that, that very advice would have been sufficient for him<sup>asws</sup>. And they said to him<sup>asws</sup>, 'All the advices are not sincere'. So I said to him<sup>asws</sup>, 'The advice is expensive'.

So Qays Bin Sa'ad stood up and he said, 'O Amir Al-Momineen<sup>asws</sup>! Al-Mugheira has prosed against you<sup>asws</sup> with such a matter, he did not intend Allah<sup>azwj</sup> by it. So bring forward a man regarding it and put back another. So if there was prevalence for you<sup>asws</sup>, he would come near to you<sup>asws</sup> with the advice, and if it was for Muawiya, he would go closer to him with the consultation'.

Then he prosed saying, 'He plotted! And the one who laid down the destruction of his position. Mugheira, 'Muawiya has been strong upon you, and by the Praise of Allah azwi, you used to be in harmony among us, and that which he has shown it, is insufficient. So Glory be to the One Who Raise the sky to its place and Spread the earth just as it is spread out'. <sup>25</sup>

(It has been narrated) from Ali<sup>asws</sup> having said: 'It was so that Rasool-Allah<sup>saww</sup> used to come to us<sup>asws</sup> every morning, and he<sup>saww</sup> was saying: 'The *Salat*! May Allah<sup>azwj</sup> have Mercy on you asws all! The Salat! [33:33] But rather, Allah Desires to Keep away the uncleanness from you, O people of the House! And to Purify you a with a Purification'. 26

He said, 'It was narrated to us by Abu Nuaym who said, 'I said to Zafar,

'How much (time) was between the words of the Prophet<sup>saww</sup> to Ali<sup>asws</sup>: 'The one whose Master I<sup>saww</sup> was so Ali<sup>asws</sup> is his Master', up to his<sup>saww</sup> expiry?' He said, 'One hundred days".27

He said, 'It was narrated to us by Al-Husayn Bin Ibrahim, well known as Abu Ulayya who said, 'I heard Abdul Salam Bin Salih who said, 'I said to Waki'e Bin Al Jarrah, 'What is the meaning of the words of the Prophet 'The one whose Master Isaww was, so Ali<sup>asws</sup> is his Master'?' He said, 'The one whose Prophet<sup>saww</sup> was, so Ali<sup>asws</sup> is his Guardian<sup>asws</sup>". <sup>28</sup>

He said, 'It was narrated to us by Abu Ali Bn Abu Yasir who said, 'It was narrated to us by Isa Bin Fashy who said,

'I proceeded from Al-Madain during one of the times, to Baghdad, and I entered a streets from the streets which did not happen to have safety for me to travel it. So I found a lot of gatherers from the companions of the Hadeeth along with the narrator. So I descended from my animal and sat down at the end of the people. When the gathering

So I said, 'May Allahazwj Honour you! I am a man from the general people, and our doctrine is the adherence to the People asws of the Household, and certain Ahadeeth have come to us obligating us that we recognise its correctness. So I would like to ask you about one of it'. He said, 'Ask'. So I said, 'The Hadeeth being reported regarding Aliasws Bin Abu Talibasws: 'Youasws are the distributor of the Fire'.

He (the narrator) said, 'And upon his right was Ahmad Bin Nasr Bin Malik. So Ahmad Bin Nasr went away denying the Hadeeth. So Ahmad (Bin Hanbal) quietened him and said, 'He is (only) asking'. Then he said, 'This Hadeeth is supportive, but in another Hadeeth is: 'O Allahazwil Befriend the one who befriends himasws, and be Inimical to the one who is inimical to him<sup>asws</sup>. It does not make it needless from it, and it is a correct Hadeeth, and it is allowed that the one who befriends him asws should happen to be in the Paradise, and the one who is inimical to him<sup>asws</sup>, to be in the Fire. Thus, the meaning of this Hadeeth is in this Hadeeth".29

I heard the chief of the Hashimites, adornment of the worshippers, Ali<sup>asws</sup> Bin Al-Husayn<sup>asws</sup> saying at Al-Medina: 'It was narrated to me<sup>asws</sup> by my<sup>asws</sup> uncle Muhammad, son of Aliasws saying, 'I heard Jabir Bin Abdullah saying: 'Rasool-Allah saww said: 'Shut the doors, all of them, except for the door of Aliasws!' – and he saww gestured by his saww hand towards his asws door". 30

Amro Bin Abu Al Migdad informed us from Abu Hamza Al Sumaly,

(It has been narrated) from Abu Al-Hamra'a, the servant of Rasool-Allah who said, 'Rasool-Allah saww said: 'When there was an ascension with me saww to the sky, I saww saw upon the right leg of the Throne (inscribed): "There is no god except Allah<sup>azwj</sup>. Muhammad<sup>azwj</sup> is Rasool<sup>saww</sup> of Allah<sup>azwj</sup>. He<sup>azwj</sup> Aided him<sup>saww</sup> with Ali<sup>asws</sup> and Helped him<sup>saww</sup> by him<sup>asws</sup>". 31

From Salmat Bin Kaheyl, from Iyaz Bin Iyaz, from his father who said,

'Ali<sup>asws</sup> Bin Abu Talib<sup>asws</sup> passed by an assembly, among whom was Salman<sup>as</sup>. So Salman<sup>as</sup> said to them, 'Be pleased and arise, so grab with a part of this one asws, for by Allah<sup>azwj</sup>, none can inform you all with the secrets of your Prophet<sup>saww</sup> apart from him<sup>asws</sup>", 32

From Ali Bin Uqba, from Salim Bin Abu Hafsa who said,

لَمَّا هَلَكَ أَبُو جَعْفَر مُحَمَّدُ بْنُ عَلِيٍّ عَ قُلْتُ لِأَصْحَابِيَ انْتَظِرُونِي حَتَّى أَدْخُلَ عَلَى أَبِي عَبْدِ اللَّهِ جَعْفَرِ بْنِ مُحَمَّدٍ فَأُعَنِّ يِهِ فِدَخَلْتُ عَلَيْهِ فَعَزَّ يْثُهُ ثُمَّ قُلْتُ إِنَّا لِلَّهِ وَ إِنَّا إِلْيْهِ رَاجِعُونَ ذَهَبَ وَ اللَّهِ مَنْ كَانَ يَقُولُ قَالَ رَسُولُ اللَّهِ ص فَلَا يُسْأَلُ عَمَّنْ بَيْنَهُ وَ بَيْنَ رَسُولِ اللَّهِ فَلَا وَ اللَّهِ وَ لَا نَرَى مِثْلُهُ أَبْداً

'When Abu Ja'far Mhammad<sup>asws</sup> Bin Ali<sup>asws</sup> passed away, I said to my companions, 'Wait for me until I go over to Abu Abdullah Ja'far asws Bin Muhammadasws, and console him<sup>asws</sup> with him<sup>asws</sup>'. So I went over to him<sup>asws</sup> and consoled him<sup>asws</sup>, then I said, 'We are for Allah<sup>azwj</sup> and to Him<sup>azwj</sup> we are returning! He<sup>asws</sup> has gone, the one<sup>asws</sup> who was saying: 'Rasool-Allah<sup>saww</sup> said (such and such)', and he<sup>asws</sup> could not be questioned about the ones who were between him<sup>asws</sup> and Rasool-Allah<sup>saww</sup>. So, by Allah<sup>azwj</sup>, we will not see the like of him<sup>asws</sup>, ever!'

قَالَ فَسَكَتَ أَبُو عَبْدِ اللَّهِ ع سَاعَةً ثُمَّ قَالَ قَالَ اللَّهُ تَعَالَى مِنْ عِبَادِي مَنْ يَتَصَدَّقُ بِشِقّ تَمْرَةٍ فَأُرَبِّيهَا لَهُ كَمَا يُرَبِّي أَحَدُكُمْ فَلُوّهُ حَتَّى أَجُعَلَهَا لَهُ مِثْلَ أُحُدٍ

He (the narrator) said, 'Abu Abdullah was silent for a while, then said: 'Allah azwi the Exalted Said: "From My<sup>azwj</sup> servants there is one who gives charity by a part of a date, So I<sup>azwj</sup> Nourish it for him just as one of you tends to be nourished. So I<sup>azwj</sup> Keep at it until Iazwi Make it for him like (the mount of) Ohad!'

We were magnifying the words of Abu Ja'far<sup>asws</sup>: 'The Rasool<sup>saww</sup> of Allah<sup>azwj</sup> the Exalted said (such and such)', without any intermediaries. So Abu Abdullah<sup>asws</sup> said to me: 'Allah<sup>azwj</sup> the Exalted Said' (such and such), without any intermediaries". <sup>33</sup>
