INTRODUCTION:

In the name of God, Most Beneficent, Most Merciful Praise be to God, the Lord of the worlds, and peace and blessings be on His Prophet Mohammed and his pure infallible progeny.

The religious authority, over its long history, had shown open and transparent attitudes in dealing well with non-Muslims, who live in Muslim countries, by calling to protect their properties and their rights and defend them. Those were the important attitudes in expressing their interest in peaceful co-existence, and their protection for other minorities such as Christians⁽¹⁾. I will try in the coming pages to shed light on bright aspects in stressing the significance of maintaining peace and security in all the conditions that the Nation may live, including maintaining rights from loss or transgression. It is a mission of great importance, highlighting the greatness of the Islamic legislation that covers all aspects of life. To explain this, we will give some examples that emphasized the humanitarian role of the Religious Authority and its recommendations to the believers as stated by his Eminence Sayed Ali Sistani in their fight against ISIS in 2014, and even before that,

following the collapse of the Baathist regime in 2003. This clearly illustrates the unified methodology adopted by the Religious Authority in dealing with the Islamic Nation's issues.

The attitudes, Fatwas, and statements of his Eminence Sayed Ali Sistani had tremendous impacts on protecting the community from total disintegration, after the US occupation of Iraq in 2003. All the statements passed by his Eminence, in addition to those declared by his agents and representatives, on maintaining the Muslims rights, and peaceful co-existence in general, and the rights of non-Muslims and minorities, in particular, were very expressive. I will mention ten examples that will give a bright image for those attitudes that history will always remember. They will be mentioned chronologically as issued, referring to the most trustworthy resources which documented the same period, i.e. "Declarations of Sayed Sistani on the Iraqi Issue", compiled by Haj Hamid Al-Khaffaf, besides the official website of his Eminence Sistani.

These excerpts, though brief (1), pave the way before researchers

for more detailed studies on those attitudes that stemmed from the Holy Islamic teachings calling for maintaining human dignity and mutual respect between all religions on the basis of their commonalities. It represents a universal message to the whole world and the different religious authorities urging for peaceful co-existence, maintaining commonalities and setting aside the differences that the enemies try to use to divide peoples. A researcher will see in the excerpts included good human examples on maintaining the unity of the Iraqi people to be taken as a practical lesson by other people living in countries of different religions and sects in their confrontation of the difficulties they experience. As the papers that I wrote earlier were published in an electronic form, and are now ready to be produced in a paper form, I would like to mention something about the Pope's important visit, just for documentation purposes for any prospective researchers, besides the important views expressed about this visit, which underlined the role of the Supreme Religious Authority in protecting the nation.

I pray the Almighty for the best acceptance of my work, and to help us all follow this approach that preserves the dignity of the Islamic Nation in its struggle against misfortune.

TEN HISTORIC ATTITUDES BY THE RELIGIOUS AUTHORITY

First: A question, among other questions, from Der Spiegel, the German magazine, to the office of his Eminence, inquiring (1): "7. There are fears from establishing a form of religious governance that might deprive the minorities from their rights, as declared by some extremists, or unjustifiably endanger the lives and properties of Iraqis from other sects. So, are such fears justified, or will everything remain as it is for the Christians and other religious minorities?

And the answer was:

A: 7- The major socio-political forces of Iraq do not call for forming a religious government; rather, they strive for a system that respects the religious parameters of the Iraqis and recognizes pluralism, justice and equity as principles. We refuse any kind of attack that may now and then be committed against non-Muslims. Such acts will be controlled after empowering the police forces and courts and enable them to perform their duties properly. The answer is crystal clear. It indicates how the Supreme Religious Authority (SRA) refuses the practices adopted by some people against non-Muslims, immediately after the fall of the past regime.

This purported religious governance is not among the priorities of the Islamic socio-political forces. The priority, however, is to maintain the unity of the Iraqis within an independent Iraqi government which respects the beliefs of the Iraqis, as the answer clearly states. Any other individual acts committed by those who do not respect the rights of non-Muslims were part of the disarray that immediately followed the US occupation of the country. These questions were raised on 24th Thul-Hijja, 1424 AH, i.e. about ten months after the occupation and fall of the regime.

وأمّا ما يقع أحياناً من بعض الاعتداءات على غير الملسمين فهو أمر مرفوض تماماً وسيتم القضاء عليها بعد تمكين قوات الشرطة والمحاكم من أداء مهامها بصورة كاملة.

SECOND: A STATEMENT BY THE SRA

The SRA issued a statement in the wake of some attacks waged against churches in Baghdad and Mosul. It stated(1):

"In a series of criminal acts that our beloved Iraq experiences, targeting its unity, stability and independence, a number of churches in Baghdad and Mosul were viciously attacked, resulting in the fall of tens of casualties and wounded, and the damage of some public and private properties. While condemning these heinous crimes and calling for joint efforts and cooperation in order to stop the attacks and attackers, we emphasize that the rights of Christian citizens, including their right to live in their homeland Iraq in peace and security, must be respected. We ask the Almighty Allah to protect the Iraqis all from any harm and bless this beloved country with security and stability; for He is the Hearer and the Responsive".

The statement is quite expressive in showing how far the SRA defends the rights of non-Muslims, especially the Christians, condemning the attacks waged against their places of worship, and respecting their rituals. And the same applies to other minorities. The SRA also stresses that they should be protected from any assault. Besides, efforts must be exerted in order to achieve full

stability for all the citizens from all sects and prevent the enemy from penetrating the community and breaking up the unity of the Iraqi people through their different nations or religions or races. All this is dependent on how vigilant and attentive the peoples is to the vicious conspiracies of the enemies who sow the seeds of division between the people of different religions in the country, and strive to stay under false pretenses such as protecting the rights of minorities, taken away by the majority. The believers and nationalists who stood against such plans are quite aware of them and how they can be used for societal divisions and continuous attacks. And it depends on how conscious the Iraqis of different religions and races are of such plans. Therefore, the SRA used to stand in the face of the plots and call the people to be aware of their impacts and call them for peaceful living, unity and abandonment of differences.

THIRD: THE SRA RELATIONS WITH THE HEADS OF OTHER RELIGIONS.

The SRA issued a statement on the death of the Supreme Pontiff John Paul II, the Pope of Vatican, stating(1): "His Eminence, the Cardinal Angelo Sodano, the Secretary of Vatican City State, We extend our condolences to you and the followers of the Catholic Church, on the demise of the Supreme Pontiff, John Paul II, Pope of the Vatican, who played a distinguished role in serving the causes of peace and religious tolerance, and thus he won the respect of people of different religions and beliefs. Mankind today is in bad need of serious and persistent efforts, especially by religious and spiritual leaders, in order to establish the values of love and peaceful co-existence, on bases of observing rights and mutual respect from the followers of different religions and ideologies. We ask the Almighty God for His help to enable us all to act for the welfare and prosperity of all mankind. We wish all the best and peace to you and all the Christians worldwide". 25th Safar, 1426 AH; i.e. 5th April, 2005.

The statement gives a clear description for the importance of establishing liaison between different religions, and on how imperative it is to remind about the common human principles on the one hand, and the divine legislations, on the other. The

importance of this invitation and exerting efforts to unite mankind under certain principles will certainly lead to establishing the values of love and peaceful co-existence. The condolences extended by the SRA refer to much greater opportunities in achieving those noble goals that drop all the excuses of the religion's enemies; besides, it represents a call for a serious human dialog and putting the rulings of legislations calling for maintaining mankind and its dignity, into practice. FOURTH: A STATEMENT BY THE SRA IN THE WAKE OF A SERIES OF ATTACKS AND BLASTS.

The SRA issued a detailed statement, following a series of horrific attacks and blasts launched against innocent citizens, causing casualties, in which it stated⁽¹⁾:

"In the name of Allah, Most Beneficent, Most Merciful

"And hold fast, all together, by the rope which Allah stretches out for you, and be not divided among yourselves; and remember with gratitude Allah's favor on you; for ye were enemies and He joined your hearts in love, so that by His Grace, ye became brethren".

I am sadly and painfully following the news of tragedies and attacks that the Iraqi people is experiencing everyday. These include terror-spreading, kidnapping, murdering, and mutilating acts of indescribable atrocity that violates all human, religious and national values. Since the very first days of occupation, I tried hard to make the Iraqis pass this crucial phase of their history without being trapped in sectarianism or racism as I was aware how gravely the Iraqi people's unity and cohesion would be threatened in such a phase. Today, I call again all the good Iraqi citizens of different sects and races to be mindful of the risks threatening the future of their country, and, in confronting them, join hands in rejecting hatred and violence and replace them with love and peaceful

dialog to settle all problems and disputes. I say to those who abuse non-Muslim citizens, be they Christians, Sabiens or others: have you not heard that when it was reported to the Commander of the Faithful (as) that a non-Muslim woman was abused by those who claimed to be Muslim, and tried to take her ornaments away by force, he (as) said: "If any Muslim dies of grief after all this he is not to be blamed but rather there is justification for him before me." So, why do you badly treat your brethren in humanity, with whom you share the same homeland?

Dear Iraqi Citizens, In the current conditions, breaking the impasse that Iraq is experiencing requires a decision by all parties to respect the sanctity of Iraqi blood, whosever it is, and stop all kinds of violence and counter-violence."

(22 Jumada Aakhira, 1427 AH)

These words of the Supreme Leader are quite clear and express the agony he was suffering due to the continuous atrocities that the terrorists commit against them, aiming at destabilizing the situation in Iraq, seizing any chance to kill the greatest number possible of people, and providing the justification for the occupation forces to stay and be immune to any attempt to demand their departure, since there were indubitable motives for their stay.

Therefore, the SRA was quite mindful of those vicious plans that aim at breaking the unity of the people and the significance of adhering to the Quranic call for unity:

"And hold fast, all of you together, to the rope of Allah, and do not separate."

for it is the optimal solution to eradicate all the evils surrounding the country. The religious leader here voices his concerns on sufferings of the Iraqi people, regardless of their religions, sects or races, since he deals with them on other common grounds. Further, he emphasizes they should all join hands, cooperate and establish peaceful co-existence between all, which is necessary to prevent the terrorists and the enemies of Iraq who support them materially and morally in order to fulfill their ends, even if the Iraqis were to pay a heavy price by giving concessions and sacrifices. What a great fatherly speech it was when he said: "and, in confronting them, join hands in rejecting hatred and violence and replace them with love and peaceful dialog." Not only did these words of his Eminence stop blood shed of innocent people, it was also considered a call for peaceful co-existence between the

fellow countrymen(1).

This answer affirms the common methodology adopted in addressing those sensitive issues concerning the followers of different religions, calling them for harmony in order to achieve decent and peaceful co-existence and avoid breaches from any party. Observation of rights and mutual respect form the optimal solution that everybody must strive to achieve, in spite of the hard conditions that Iraq experiences in particular, let alone the actions, declarations and violations by those who struggle against

SIXTH: A STATEMENT BY THE SRA AFTER ABUSING THE HOLY OURAN BY AN AMERICAN PASTOR.

The SRA passed a special statement when Terry Jones⁽¹⁾, an American Pastor, abused the Holy Quran by trying to burn copies

of it, as reported by the media. The statement said(2):

"In the name of Allah, Most Beneficent, Most Merciful. The mass media is reporting about an American pastor insisting on burning copies of the Holy Quran as an expression of his hatred for Noble Islam. This shameful behavior goes against the missions of the spiritual and religious leaderships, which require establishing the values of love, peaceful co-existence based on the observation of rights and mutual respect between the followers of different religions and ideologies. The SRA, while strongly denouncing abusing the Great Quran and affirming the need to prevent it, calls the Muslims, wherever they are located, to exercise utmost

restraint and refrain from any act that may abuse the followers of Christianity, recalling God's saying:

"O ye who believe! stand out firmly for Allah, as witnesses to fair dealing, and let not the hatred of others to you make you swerve to wrong and depart from justice. Be just: that is next to piety: and fear Allah. For Allah is well-acquainted with all that ye do". 29th Ramadhan, 1431 AH; i.e. 9th September, 2010.

These words demonstrate how profound the wisdom that the SRA imparted on some conducts by some enemies of Islam from other religions in world countries that are densely populated by Muslims. These acts, in fact, aims at sowing the seeds of division and fighting, spreading hatred and grudge among the followers of different religions; besides, they negatively have effect on those who live in one country. Despite the heinous crime committed by that pastor who, according to his extremist thinking, believe that their enemy is Islam due to a misconception, after he had seen atrocious acts committed by some terrorists, or to show his animosity to Islam and Muslims, or due to his ignorance of the Islamic teachings, and though he belongs to a Christian school, the SRA did not bear the Christian school responsible for the action committed by that pastor, since it highlights that religion cannot be seen or evaluated by a person or few persons. Rather, it calls for maintaining peaceful co-existence and refraining from attacking Christians, for such actions are inconsistent with the Holy Islamic teachings. It also

urges not to be provoked by such extremist Christian calls and make them justifications to break the social unity of communities with different religions as is the case with Iraq.

The SRA even calls Muslims not to be driven by emotions, and refer instead to the Islamic teachings which hold no party responsible for actions other than those involved. Such behaviors must not be taken as a standard for a whole sect or an entire nation. Maintaining ourselves against being involved in sins is the best way to ensure protecting the community from perversion and enhance love, cooperation and peaceful co-existence.

SEVENTH: SRA DIRECTIONS TO THE FIGHTERS AGAINST ISIS AFTER ACHIEVING GREAT VICTORIES.

The moral support provided by the SRA to those who answered its Fatwa of Defense to fight against ISIS and protect the sanctities

was considerable⁽¹⁾. The support took the form of a series of continuous actions in order to ensure continuity of victories. The most interesting issue of the SRA was the directions that includes 20 items summing up the most important things that the fighters

must observe. Item (7) especially says⁽²⁾:

"Beware not to abuse non-Muslims, no matter what religion they may follow, since they are guaranteed protection by Muslims. Those who would abuse their sanctities are considered traitors and treacherous. Betrayal and treachery are the worst actions as judged by conscience and the Almighty. God says in the Quran, when talking about non-Muslims: "Allah forbids you not, with regard to those who fight you not for (your) Faith nor drive you out of your homes, from dealing kindly and justly with them: for

Allah loveth those who are just."(1) More than that, a Muslim must not allow sacrilege to the beliefs of non-Muslims who live under the protection of Muslims. He should also show as much solicitude for them as he should for his family..."

22nd Rabee Aakhir, 1436 AH.

This point of the SRA directions, concerning keeping non-Muslims safe and secure is one of the SRA parameters that it has always called for. The SRA has always highlighted this point in these directions, besides in other statements; a fact that reflects the reality of the Islamic legislations. We can feel the dire warning against violating the sanctities of non-Muslims who live within the areas of battles or other areas. Not only do these directions prevent aggression against them, they also consider such actions treachery and treason for the people and their rights and a violation for the peaceful existence in a Muslim country. Following these directions means adherence to the Islamic teachings through defending their rights and stopping any aggression against them.

SRA warns the fighters that they are not allowed to punish people for being different from them in religion or belief, or attack them because they are within the towns fought or liberated, or that the ISIS terrorists or their families are from those towns, for all these conditions do not justify fighting them.

The SRA also highlights that the Islamic law stresses through the Holy Quran and narrations, the need to protect the innocent,

including the non-Muslims, and their properties. They should not, the SRA confirms, do as those criminals did in dealing with innocents and non-Muslims by adopting the policy of looting their properties and confiscating their rights, even if those criminals were the residents of those towns. Almighty God says:

"Who receiveth guidance, receiveth it for his own benefit: who goeth astray doth so to his own loss: No bearer of burdens can

bear the burden of another:"(1)

And one of the Holy narrations stated that Imam Ali (as) said: "It is not permissible for a Muslim to intimidate another Muslim" (2). In respect to the rights of non-Muslims living within the Muslim Community, Imam Sajjad (as) states: And the right of those under the protection of Islam is that you should accept from them what God has accepted from them, and fulfill what God has established for them under His protection and covenant, and entrust them to Him in what they are required to carry out, and are obliged to do. And you should judge among them with the judgments of God that He commanded for you regarding the conditions of dealing with them, and do not wrong them as long as they honor God's covenant and fulfill their pledge. And the pledge of the Prophet, may God's peace be upon him and his household, is a barrier since it is reported that he said: «I am the adversary of whoever oppresses one who has a treaty.» (3)

EIGHTH: A WORD BY THE SRA REPRESENTATIVE, HIS EMINENCE SAYED AHMED AL-SAFI, IN A FRIDAY SERMON.

The SRA on more than one occasion underlined the importance of protecting the rights of citizens of all communities, providing them with full services and defending them. It also instructed the fighters to return the citizens to their homes that they left because of the war against the terrorists, and that the SRA representatives should provide aids to those families. In a speech, Sayed Ahmed

Al-Safi said(11): Tens of thousands of Turkoman, Shabak, Christian citizens and of other minorities are living in hard conditions these days because they have been forced to leave their homes after the terrorists took hold of their towns and villages in Nineveh and other governorates. The efforts exerted for their convenience and mitigating their suffering are still below the standard required. The Federal Government will bear full responsibility towards the displaced people. Besides, the Government of Kurdistan and international organizations are called to pay more attention to them. These citizens must have the chance to go back to their homes after restoring peace and security.in their areas. Their displacement should not be taken as a step towards demographic changes in those areas.

The speech confirms the hard conditions which the Iraqis of different races and religions experience, and that they should be protected and defended against the criminal ISIS groups which committed murders, forcible migration and displacement. It is a clear approach expressed in many situations by the SRA in defending these communities.

In addressing the international and governmental authorities, the SRA was very eager to stress the need for a comprehensive solution for the suffering of these communities, and even to hold them responsible for maintaining their rights. This clearly indicates the fatherly spirit of the SRA and how it carried the pains of the Iraqi citizens without any discrimination; a feature which refers to a perfect feeling of nationalism and citizenship. It is a clear message to the whole nation to follow that and confirm the unity of the Iraqi territories, the need to maintain their entity and pluralism within them, and not to use the criminal acts of forcible migration as a pretext to uproot the characteristics of those areas, and prevent their citizens from living in peace. It also calls to help them return to their homes, and have their properties back after they were seized by ISIS under different pretexts.



NINTH: A WORD BY THE SRA REPRESENTATIVE, HIS EMINENCE SHEIKH ABDULMAHDI AL-KERBALAE, IN A FRIDAY SERMON.

The SRA, through the Friday Sermon delivered at Imam Hussein's Holy Courtyard, underlined those basic principles in its call to maintain the unity of the Iraqi people with all their religions and communities, and protect them from any harm. In a sermon delivered by Sheikh Abdulmahdi Al-Karbalae⁽¹⁾, the SRA said: "We made it clear, on more than one occasion, that the call to volunteer in the Iraqi military and security forces was issued with the aim to provide protection for all Iraqis, of different races and communities, and safeguard their families and sanctities from the terrorist strangers.. We emphasize to them the need to strictly adhere to the maintenance of all citizens, and not to abuse any innocent individual, regardless of his/her religion, sect, race or political doctrine. Therefore, beware of being the cause of shedding one drop of innocent blood, or vandalizing the properties of innocent people".

The discourse here is conspicuously calling to protect non-Muslims, the followers of other religions, besides Muslims, and their public and private properties. These pieces of advice were

embodied in the practical attitudes of the fighters. The SRA also supported all the citizens who sustained damages from ISIS which committed heinous crimes with their terrorist attacks, because the security of Iraqis of different religions is the responsibility of those fighters.



TENTH: DECLARATION OF HIS EMINENCE SAYED ALI SISTANI TO MR. BAN KI-MOON, THE UNITED NATIONS SECRETARY GENERAL.

The position of his Eminence Sayed Sistani was fixed on how the SRA deals with the nation as a whole in terms of maintaining unity between the Iraqi communities, and making this unity their first concern. He affirmed that to all the delegations that had the honor to visit his Eminence, especially the United Nations ones which were in ongoing contact with his Eminence. He said in

his meeting with Ban Ki-Moon, the UN Secretary General⁽¹⁾: "I always call for staying away from sectarianism in discourse and in practice. Though most of the car bombs and explosive devices targeted Shia-dominated areas, I always confirmed that the Iraqi Sunnis are innocent of such crimes which are basically committed by foreign intruders. Displacing the minorities including the Shia Turkmens, Christians, and Shabak people is condemned. We did our best to provide assistance to the displaced people and migrants. The Holy Shrines institutions also did their utmost in this respect". In spite of the vicious attacks that targeted the Shia cities and Shia religious and academic institutions causing deaths, injuries and destruction, his Eminence's call was meant to cover the whole Iraqi people and not confined to defend the Shia community alone. He

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

In the name of Allah, Most Beneficent, Most Merciful

This morning, His Eminence Sayyid Al-Sistani met with the Supreme Pontiff (Pope Francis), Pope of the Catholic Church and Head of State of the Vatican.

During the meeting, the discussion revolved around the great challenges that humanity faces in this era and the role of faith in God Almighty and His messages, and commitment to high moral values in overcoming them.

His Eminence talked about the injustice, oppression, poverty, religious and intellectual persecution, suppression of basic freedoms and the absence of social justice, especially the wars, acts of violence, economic blockade, displacement and so on, especially the Palestinian people in the occupied territories.

His Eminence indicated the role that the great religious and

spiritual leaders should play in curbing these tragedies, and what is hoped for by urging the concerned parties - especially those with great powers - to prioritize reason and wisdom and to reject the language of war, and not to promote their self-interest over the rights of the people to live in freedom and dignity, and stressing the importance of concerted efforts to consolidate the values of harmony, peaceful coexistence and human solidarity in all societies, based on fostering rights and mutual respect among followers of different religions and intellectual trends. His Eminence praised the status and glorious history of Iraq as well as its people from various faiths. He also expressed his hope that Iraq would surpass its current ordeal soon. He affirmed his interest in Christian citizens living like all Iraqis in peace and security while preserving all their constitutional rights. Grand Ayatollah Sistani also pointed out part of the role that the religious authority played in protecting Iraqis and all those who had suffered injustice and harm in the incidents of past years, especially during the period during which the terrorists seized vast areas in several Iraqi provinces where they carried out criminal acts there. 


